This month our focus is on **Social Connections**- We know that social connections are important for our mental health and wellness. Holidays are a great time to build those connections with your children, family, and friends.



As social beings, the desire for a sense of connection and need for community is not specific to the holidays. However, the holidays can heighten expectations or make unfulfilled expectations more impactful.
