The benefits of breastfeeding

WHO recommends exclusive breastfeeding for the first six months of life, with continued breastfeeding along with appropriate complementary foods up to two years of age or beyond.

Breast milk contains:

- ▲ antioxidants
- ▲ enzymes
- ▲ antibodies

Breastfeeding reduces the baby's risk of:

- ▼ obesity ▼ asthma
- ▼ cardiovascular disease
- ▼ diabetes (type 2)



Breastfeeding

Breast milk provides infants

- reduces the mother's risk of:
 - ▼ breast and ovarian cancer ▼ cardinvascular disease
 - ▼ obesity
 - osteonorosis

The more you breastfeed, the greater the benefits

Breastfed children are less susceptible to chronic and infectious diseases

Breastfeeding promotes cognitive development in children


