The Protective Factors: Nurturing & Attachment

The Protective Factors are strengths all families may have and can build upon that support resilient, thriving children and families. They are: parental resilience, social connections, knowledge of parenting & child development, concrete support in times of need, and social & emotional competence of children.

These factors help to reduce stress, enhance wellbeing and positive parent-child relationships that are the foundation for healthy development in children. This month, our focus is on **nurturing & attachment.** The parent-child relationship is the first and most important relationship for modeling to our children what a loving and safe relationship feels like.

Attachment is the connection we form with our children from the moment they are born. By responding to their unique needs with consistency, sensitivity, and warmth, we are nurturing a secure attachment in our children. Secure attachment between a loving caregiver and infant is the foundation to a lifetime of emotional health and resilience.

By providing our children with a safebase to fall back on, we give them the opportunity to grow and explore as the individuals they are. So how do we create this secure attachment and form a nurturing relationship with our children? Read on below for a few ideas to use throughout development. STORIES INSIDE THIS ISSUE:

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Infancy

- Responsive care to our infant's needs such as hunger, diapering, & being held
- Plenty of cuddles & skin-to-skin bonding time
- Talking, singing, & reading to them, delighting in them
- Warmth & sensitivity in our tone of voice & body language

Toddler years

- Patience as they develop new skills & independence
- Celebrating their new discoveries & progress
- Remaining calm through tantrums or meltdowns
- Talking, singing, & reading together
- Naming & validating feelings

Preschool & beyond

- Talking about feelings & validating that they are all okay
- Modeling self-care & healthy ways to manage emotions (breathe, play, mindfulness etc)
- Be curious about their interests,
 & do things they love with them
- Continue responding with warmth & sensitivity - you're their safe space to return to
