COVID VACCINATION CLINIC INFORMATION

Stay informed about where we are with our COVID vaccination program and when appointments are available.

- 1. **Fill out the COVID-19 Vaccine Sign-up Survey on our website at www.bldhd.org.** This does not schedule an appointment, but puts your information on a list so that we can contact you via email when appointments for your priority group are available. If you have already filled out the Survey form, you do not need to fill it out again but you may want to subscribe to the Vaccine Updates as well.
- 2. **Subscribe to receive COVID-19 Vaccine updates:** Enter your email address on our website at www.bldhd.org.
- 3. **Seniors without internet/email can call 231-715-5557** and follow the prompts to the COVID information line. You will hear general information and then be able to leave your name/phone number and someone will call you when appointments are available.

It will take months to vaccinate all those in the current priority group so please continue to be patient. Vaccine supply is very limited and we are only able to open up appointments one week at a time. We will email the scheduling link (or have someone call, if no email address) as appointments are available, starting with those who have registered earliest.
