The Protective Factors: Social-Emotional Competence of Children

The Protective Factors are strengths all families may have and can build upon that support resilient, thriving children and families. They are: parental resilience, social connections, knowledge of parenting & child development, concrete support in times of need, social & emotional competence of children, and nurturing & attachment.

These factors help to reduce stress, enhance wellbeing and positive parent-child relationships that are the foundation for healthy development in children. This month, our focus is on **social-emotional competence of children**.

As the weather continues to get colder and the days become shorter, it is a great time to spend with our family – making memories, celebrating traditions, and sharing stories. The holidays remind us of thankfulness and expressing gratitude. We may help our children learn gratitude through modeling.

Saying thank you to another family member, friend, or neighbor teaches our children that we value kindness and shows them how to express our appreciation to others. Expressing gratitude directly to our children is also important! Saying thanks for the little things (like picking up toys) and the big things ("I'm so thankful you are my child") shows them that they are valued and builds up their sense of self-worth.

Another idea this month is to share family stories with your children. Family stories are an important part of a child's self-identity, and can teach children what their family values are, history, and important traditions – these are all important aspects of the social–emotional development of children. The holidays are a great time to share family stories while making new memories!


