The Protective Factors: Social Connections

The Protective Factors are strengths all families may have and can build upon that support resilient, thriving children and families. They are: parental resilience, social connections, knowledge of parenting & child development, concrete support in times of need, social & emotional competence of children, and nurturing & attachment.

These factors help to reduce stress, enhance wellbeing and positive parent-child relationships that are the foundation for healthy development in children. This month, our focus is on **Social Connections.** We all need a community of support to share the "ups and downs" of life with, and having supportive social connections helps not only us grown-ups, but our children as well.

How do children benefit from our social connections?

- A caregiver's positive relationships give children access to other caring adults. "It takes a village"
- Caregivers model healthy relational skills including empathy, communication, and conflict-resolution
- When we get support from others, we can care for our children more easily


